Requirements:

Post certification preferred but not required.

3 to 5 years of experience preferred but not required

18 Years of age and a citizen of the United States

Must have or be eligible to obtain a Montana Driver's License

Must be of excellent moral character with no criminal history

A thorough background investigation will be conducted

A medical physical and psychological exam will be required of the top applicant at the expense of Jefferson County

Must be willing and able to do shift work to include nights, weekends and holidays

Beginning Salary: approximately \$53110.36 annually plus benefits.
